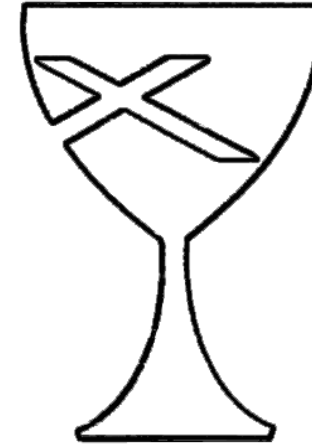

Message from Russ

If you knew you only had one week left to live, what would you do with it? I know my schedule would change dramatically. Instead of my weekly business trip to Iowa, there would be walks with my lovely wife, a soccer game with my boys, a special lunch with my beautiful daughters, visits and phone calls with family and friends and a special worship jam session with Ironic Outcome members and my good friend, Jason Drury. I would want all of them to know how much I love them and how much they have blessed my life.

Most of us will not know when we only have a week left to live. That's why it's so important to consider what we would do and incorporate those things into our daily schedule now.

Jesus, on the other hand, knew exactly his time. He knew when he entered Jerusalem to the shouts of, "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest!", that some of these very same people, in just a few days would be shouting, "Crucify him!". Jesus knew he only had a week left. This Sunday, we will look at what Jesus did with his last week. It tells us a lot about the character of Christ.

I encourage all to come. As importantly, I encourage all to invite an unchurched friend or family member. I want to share a brief story.

When our first child was born, my wife, Sharon, and I started looking for a church to attend. It was important to both of us to raise our children in the instruction of the Lord. God led us to a wonderful little church in Westminster, Colorado. One thing I could always count on was, no matter what the topic our Pastor was teaching on, at some point during his message, he would clearly share the message of salvation. I learned that even though I did not always feel comfortable witnessing to my friends/family, I could invite them to church with the full assurance they would hear the great promise of hope contained in the gospel message of Jesus. On more than one occasion, someone I invited came to a saving knowledge of Christ.

It is the Easter season. Many of our friends and family might only consider attending church during this time. I promise you, if they come, they will hear the great promise of God's love, extended to each of us through the sacrifice of His son Jesus. Please invite a friend this Sunday and next. Who knows, maybe they will come back the Sunday after on their own. The Spirit of God is like that.

Thank you to the dozens of church members that will sacrifice so much of their time during these next two weeks to extend the great message of hope to our congregation and community! Because of your love and sacrifice, lives will be changed! Great is your reward! May God richly bless you!

Every baptized person is called to ministry. The Education for Ministry (EFM) program provides people from all walks of life with the education "to be" Christians and to carry out their ministry. All Christians need a Christian Education which supports their faith and which gives them confidence and prepares them to express that faith in day-to-day events.

EFM is a worldwide program developed by the School of Theology of The University of the South. EFM is for the laity of the church. Thousands of persons have completed this four-year program. Students enroll one year at a time; the first year is study of the Old Testament; the second year the New Testament; third year study of church history; and fourth year study of theology and ethics. This is not a regular bible study. It is an in-depth theological reflection of the past and present times. Attending the EFM class takes time and commitment so prayerfully consider whether God is calling you to be involved. Our Mentor is Helen Birkinsha. 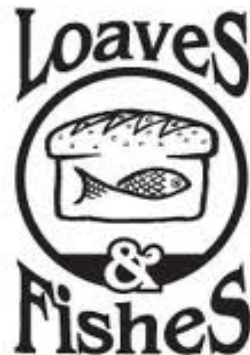
