## Quiet Time

In the last edition of *The Christian Visitor* we briefly discussed the importance of continuing to seek spiritual growth and the intentionality that requires – especially as adults. We continued that conversation the following Sunday in a message that explored personal inventory as a powerful spiritual tool and a very helpful way to track personal progress (if you missed the message you can listen online at our church website [www.fccatchison.net](http://www.fccatchison.net)). In this edition, I would like to present another very powerful spiritual tool – daily devotions.

Jesus set a precedent for spending time on his own in prayer (see Matthew 14:23; Mark 6:46; Luke 6:12). We don't know exactly what he did during these periods, we just know that it was "alone" time – just him and God. The most important (and often most difficult) element of devotional time is just that – making time. For some people, mornings work best. For others, it is in the evening or over the lunch hour. Find what works for you and then begin exploring different ways to spend that time (5-15 minutes is a great place to start). Here are a few possibilities: reading the Bible, listening to meaningful hymns or worship music, time in silence, breathing exercises, journaling, speaking to God, listening to God, making a gratitude list, listening to sermons or speakers, and reading a daily devotion.

I personally practice a combination of these (I call it *Quiet Time*), but a constant for many years has been reading a daily devotional book. Different works have spoken to me in different seasons of my life and my favorites include: *My Utmost for His Highest* by Oswald Chambers; *Streams in the Desert* edited by Mrs. Charles Cowman; *Come Away, My Beloved* by Frances J. Roberts; and, (presently) *Jesus Calling* by Sarah Young. These are all amazing books and I recommend each highly.

Communal time in study and in worship (like we do on Sundays) is immensely important, but opportunities alone with God are too. Both feed and nourish our spirit in a unique way and both are vital. If you have any questions about incorporating daily devotions into your life please let me know. If you would like to share a practice along these lines that has been meaningful to you I would love to hear about it!
