## *A Firm Foundation*

On Sunday, January 7, one hundred-and-seventy-five of our church members (those who were able to make it to services despite the harsh weather) stood in our sanctuary and we prayed together. We rededicated our hearts and lives to Christ and we also committed to putting a single goal at the top of our list of 2018 resolutions – to grow deeper this year in our relationship with God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit. It was a powerful moment at both services and not something I will soon forget.

If you were not able to join us on that particular Sunday don't worry about missing out. Rededicating our lives to Christ is something we actually do on a daily basis. And it is certainly not too late to put growing deeper spiritually at the top of your New Year priority list. In fact, if you haven't already, I would invite you to pray now. Ask God to help you place Him first in your life – above everything else. Ask Him to draw near to you and give you courage to follow where He leads you this year. When seeking God becomes our number one priority it is amazing how everything else seems to fall into place. And the peace and joy that we begin to experience is even more amazing.

Our current message series, *A Firm Foundation*, has focused on practical ways we can begin to grow deeper in our relationship with God. If you missed any message in the last three weeks (or in the last few years for that matter) you can listen on our church website at [fccatchison.net](http://fccatchison.net). Remember that you can tune in on KAIR Radio each Sunday at 10:00 AM as well.

This message series has been exploring various aspects of an image that is found in many places throughout scripture – our lives as being like a spiritual building or house that God desires to establish and strengthen (See 1 Peter 2:1-7; Luke 6:46-49; Matthew 7:21-27). The most important part of any structure is a firm foundation, which means the right stones in the right places. The first stone (also called the setting stone, founding stone or corner stone) is Christ. A few of the ways we can ensure that Christ is our corner stone include: prayer time, devotions, worship, and asking him for guidance throughout our day. We also talked about the necessity of action (putting our beliefs into practice) and explored the importance of right relationships with the people in our lives as a relevant part of having a right relationship with God (1 Peter 2:1-3, Matthew 5:23-24). This Sunday we will continue this series with a look at stewardship as another key element in growing deeper in our relationship with God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit.

I am excited about what God is building in and through us and I am especially excited about this year in ministry together. As we each grow deeper and stronger in our walk with God our church and its' ministries will grow stronger as well. I am so thankful to be on this journey with such amazing people.



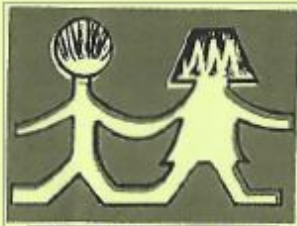
